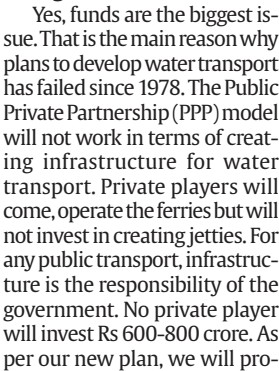


First list of farm loan waiver today, 20,000 farmers to benefit: CM

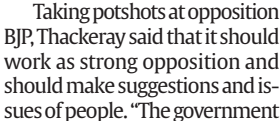


Work on constructing jetties for the Ro-Ro services are going on. By June, we will be able to complete the Nerul jetty, which will play an important role in providing water transport connectivity between Navi Mumbai and other regions, including Kalyan, Thane and Mumbai. Apart from this, construction of a jetty in Gorai is also going on at a good pace and will be ready by September this year. Work on six other jetties — Manori, Narangi, Bhayander, Borivli, Belapur and



To decongest Gateway of India, we are working on two new jetties. One at NCPA and one near the radio club. The jetty near NCPA will accommodate most of the traffic for the proposed Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj statue in sea. However, the jetty which will come up near the radio club will ease ferry traffic of Gateway of India by nearly 50 per cent. We have signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Mumbai Port Trust for a jetty as well. The new jetty will cost nearly Rs 100 crore and will have the facility of a small cruise terminal.

While the government has planned to bring 13 Bills in the Assembly session, it however does not mention about bringing a Bill to make Marathi language compulsory in schools of all boards in the state.



Deshmukh said he along with the five senior Home Department officials had gone to Andhra Pradesh to get information on the DISHA Act. "We are planning to bring a similar law in the state with some changes in it. We have set up a committee of five senior officials that will give the report by March 30. Then, it will be put before the cabinet and then will bring it in the next Assembly session," he said.

Speaking on Pawar's stiff opposition to transfer the Elgaar Parishad case to the National Investigation Agency (NIA) and seeking a Special Investigation Team (SIT) probe instead, Fadnavis said, "During my tenure as chief minister (he was also in charge of Home), there was a thorough probe."

Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray clarified in Mumbai on the eve of the Budget Session that he didn't handover the Elgaar Parishad probe to the NIA. "I didn't hand over the case to the NIA but the Centre took it in its right. We have expressed our displeasure on it as they have shown mistrust on the state's investigative agency," he added.

While ruling out any cover-up in the investigation by his government, Fadnavis said, "Neither the Bombay High Court nor the Supreme Court had any objection to the investigation by the then state police. However, it is evident that the NCP president is keen on revoking the matter with a definite agenda."

Accordingly, the then BJP-Sena government initiated a probe. Bhide was given a clean chit but action was taken against Ekbote. "By setting up an SIT to re-look into the Bhima Koregaon case, Pawar wants to hold Hindutvawadis responsible for the violence," Fadnis said.

"Why is Pawar so keen on a state probe into Elgaar Parishad? The Maoist link was not limited to Maharashtra. It was inter-linked to various states which has to be probed by central agencies like the NIA. There are adequate documents to establish the role of Maoists," he said.

Elgaar Parishad was an evening event organised at Pune's Shaniwar Wada on December 31, 2017, a day before the 200th anniversary of the Battle of Bhima Koregaon, which every year attracts lakhs of pilgrims to a war memorial in the village of Koregaon Bhima, 25 km northwest of Pune. On this occasion, violence broke out in areas around Pune, resulting in the death of one person and injuries to several others.

While praising Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray for supporting the Citizenship (Amendment) Act (CAA) and National Population Register (NPR) and agreeing to the National Investigation Agency (NIA) taking over the probe in the Elgaar Parishad case, Opposition leader Devendra Fadnis said, "The BJP has decided to boycott the customary tea party of the Maha Vikas Aghadi government on the eve of the Budget Session."

Fadnavis on Sunday met members of Sakal Maratha Morcha, who are protesting for the last 27 days demanding government jobs, and assured that he would raise their issue in the Assembly in the Budget Session.



STEPPING IN to curb arbitrary recruitment to plum postings with Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority (MHADA), the state administration has barred the authority from recruiting officials on deputation without its concurrence. Orders issued by the state's housing department last week make it clear that all such recruitment will now have to be cleared by high-level committees appointed by the government. Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray's office will sanction all appointments on deputation for Class I posts and Housing Minister Jitendra Awhad will approve Class II postings. Deputations to lucrative posts in the MHADA are much sought after, especially by officials from the all-powerful revenue department.

THE BIG daddies are at it again. Sources said the builders' lobby has started pushing the demand for a further drop in premiums on additional floor space index. While Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray has not yet given into the pressure, we have been told that the CMO has asked authorities in the urban development department to consider the demand. A top-notch builder, with past controversies to his name, has been frequenting Mantralaya a lot these days and has become a subject of debate in the corridors of power.

THE CRIME Branch of Mumbai Police on Sunday claimed to have detected a human trafficking racket while investigating a potential terror threat. Police received a tip-off that seven persons were being sent to Pakistan via Mumbai to undergo training at terrorist camps, but when they were detained it was revealed during the interrogation that they were being smuggled into the USA, police said. They added that so far no terror links have emerged.

to be Rameesh Makhan, stated that this group will arrive in Pakistan to undergo training at terror camps and then return to India. "However, the interrogation revealed that the group was not going to Pakistan but to the US via Canada," Nawalade said.

He said, "We also found that the person who tipped us off was not named Rameesh Makhan, but Rizwan Sayyed. He is a Pakistan-origin man living in the US. We learnt that the family members of these seven were in the US and had paid between \$25,000 and \$30,000 to Sayyed for the trafficking operation."

“Police received information through mail on February 20 at seven persons, including a Pakistan-based woman, were likely to go to Pakistan via Dubai from Mumbai,” said Deputy Commissioner of Police (Preventive) Datta Nalawade. Nalawade added that the sender of the mail, who claimed
